Study Abroad with Bunker Hill Community College

Experience another culture first-hand through the BHCC Study Abroad Program! Spend up to seven weeks in one of 17 amazing countries and earn up to eight academic credits.

Bunker Hill Community College's Study Abroad Scholarship provides funds for students to study program

in their choice of 17 countries. The scholarship covers 80 percent of the total cost of the program, with students responsible for the remaining 20 percent. The scholarship covers all reasonable expenses, including tuition and fees, room and board, airfare and other transportation, as well as books and personal expenses.

The scholarships are funded by the Student Government Association and the College. While faculty, staff and interested community members also take part in the Study Abroad Program, scholarships are available only to qualified BHCC students.

Eligibility Requirements

- You must be enrolled in a BHCC degree or certificate program for the Fall 2016 and Spring 2017 semesters, either part time or full time.
- You must have completed 12 or more college-level credits at BHCC by December 31, 2016.
- You must have a GPA of 2.7 or higher through the end of the Spring 2017 semester in all college-level courses.



BHCC Study Abroad Scholarship Program Options

Argentina

Dates: Four weeks in June or July

- Study intensive Spanish in Buenos Aires
- Live with an Argentinean family
- Participate in historical and cultural excursions
- Earn three credits in conversational Spanish, and three credits for an additional course

Total cost of program	\$5,750
80%–BHCC scholarship	\$4,600
20%–Cost to student	\$1,150

Belgium

Dates: Seven weeks in late May to July

- Study at the Vesalius College in Brussels, “The Capital of Europe”
- Choose between living in host family’s apartment or international students housing
- Participate in historical and cultural excursions
- Earn three credits in a variety of subjects

Total cost of program	\$6,778
80%–BHCC scholarship	\$5,422
20%–Cost to student	\$1,356

Costa Rica

Dates: Two weeks in May

- Study biological field techniques with BHCC faculty
- Live in camp-style dormitories
- Learn about the remarkable biodiversity of the Costa Rican rainforest
- Participate in guided field excursions and practice Spanish
- Earn three or four credits in Environmental Science

Total cost of program	\$2,369
80%–BHCC scholarship	\$1,895
20%–Cost to student	\$474



Czech Republic

Dates: Four weeks June to July

- Requires a 3.0 GPA
- Take courses taught in English at the University of New York in Prague (UNYP)
- Live in an apartment close to the university
- Earn 3 credits in a wide variety of subjects

Total cost of program	\$5,049
80%–BHCC scholarship	\$4,039
20%–Cost to student	\$1,010

Denmark

Dates: Three weeks in June

- Requires 3.0 GPA and 1½ years of college completed
- Study a wide range of academically challenging courses in Copenhagen
- Choose between living in residence halls or with other students near the center of the city
- Take part in a one-week study tour of Europe
- Earn three credits in international business and economics, humanities or social sciences

Total cost of program	\$6,015
80%–BHCC scholarship	\$4,812
20%–Cost to student	\$1,203

Ecuador

Dates: Four weeks in July

- Earn four academic credits in intensive Spanish in Guayaquil from elementary to advanced level
- Stay with Ecuadorian family
- Participate in excursions to cultural and tourist sites
- Study at the Universidad Católica de Santiago de Guayaquil

Total cost of program	\$5,554
80%–BHCC scholarship	\$4,443
20%–Cost to student	\$1,111

England

Dates: Four weeks in July

- Study at Kingston University (KU) in London
- Live in a single room in a residence hall
- Discover London day and night while taking in the theatre and museums
- Earn three credits in a variety of subjects

Total cost of program	\$8,100
80%–BHCC scholarship	\$6,480
20%–Cost to student	\$1,620

France

Dates: Four weeks in early June to late July

- Study intensive French at the Institute Français des Alpes in southeastern France
- Live with a French family or in dormitory type accommodations
- Participate in optional excursions to cultural and tourist sites
- Earn six credits in Conversational French

Total cost of program	\$6,718
80%–BHCC scholarship	\$5,374
20%–Cost to student	\$1,344

Greece

Dates: Four weeks June to July

- Study at the American College of Thessaloniki
- Live in an apartment with other students
- Participate in historical and cultural excursions
- Earn at least three credits in a variety of subjects

Total cost of program	\$7,900
80%–BHCC scholarship	\$6,320
20%–Cost to student	\$1,580

India

Dates: Four weeks July to August

- Requires 1½ years of college completed
- Study at The National Management School (NMS) in Chennai
- Earn six credits in Business
- Live in apartments within a few miles of campus
- Interact with CEOs from some of India's top international corporations

Total cost of program	\$8,220
80%–BHCC scholarship	\$6,576
20%–Cost to student	\$1,644

Ireland

Dates: Four weeks in early June to late July

- Requires 3.0 or higher GPA
- Study Irish culture or Irish language in Galway
- Live in apartments, on-campus student village or in home stays
- Earn six credits in Irish Studies

Total cost of program	\$7,773
80%–BHCC scholarship	\$6,218
20%–Cost to student	\$1,555

Italy

Dates: Four weeks in June

- Study intensive Italian or choose from a variety of courses taught in English at the Lorenzo de'Medici–The Italian International Institute in Florence
- Live in a shared apartment
- Participate in weekend excursions to cultural and tourist sites
- Earn three or four credits

Total cost of program	\$7,898
80%–BHCC scholarship	\$6,318
20%–Cost to student	\$1,580

Mexico

Dates: Four weeks June to July

- Study intensive Spanish in Guadalajara, Mexico
- Live with Mexican family
- Participate in historical and cultural excursions
- Earn four credits in Spanish

Total cost of program	\$3,695
80%–BHCC scholarship	\$2,956
20%–Cost to student	\$739

People's Republic of China

Dates: Four weeks in June to July

- Study intensive Mandarin and business in Shanghai
- Live in a foreign student dormitory



at Shanghai University with an optional weekend homestay

- Participate in weekend excursions to cultural and tourist sites
- Earn six credits in Chinese, business or Chinese culture

Total cost of program	\$6,979
80%–BHCC scholarship	\$5,583
20%–Cost to student	\$1,396



Peru

Dates: Five weeks in May to June

- Study Spanish at Universidad San Ignacio de Loyola in Cusco or receive instruction in English in Inca architecture, art and design in Cusco, history of the Inca civilization, contemporary society of culture in Peru, biodiversity of Peru, and photography
- Live in shared, furnished apartments
- Earn six credits

80%–BHCC scholarship	\$4,938
20%–Cost to student	\$1,234

Dates: Four weeks in May to June

- Study at the University of Stirling
- On-campus apartment style accommodations
- Participate in historical and cultural excursions
- Earn six credits in liberal arts or humanities
- Requires 3.0 GPA or higher

Total cost of program	\$7,416
80% –BHCC scholarship	\$5,933
20%–Cost to student	\$1,483



Spain

Dates: Four weeks late June to July

- Study intensive Spanish in Santander, Spain
- Choose between living with host family or in La Playa residence
- Participate in historical and cultural excursions
- Earn four credits in a variety of subjects

Total cost of program	\$5,064
80% –BHCC scholarship	\$4,051
20%–Cost to student	\$1,013
